

Pray For Israel

Prayer is God's design to bring about His will in the earth. Through prayer, He has given us the awesome privilege of partnering with Him. In changing times and circumstances, these are Scripture-based prayers that can be prayed at any time, regardless of what is happening in Israel. Our hope is that you will return to this prayer guide time and time again. We encourage you to look up and study the Scripture references, put the prayer requests into your own words, mark those that are most meaningful to you as you intercede, and add your own prayers as well.

Intercessory prayer guide - For Israel

Jerusalem and all the people and land of Israel

- ★ Pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6)
- ★ For the people of Israel to come to know their Messiah, Yeshua (Psalm 40:7; Isaiah 53)
- ★ For her borders to be secure (Exodus 23:31a)
- ★ For Jerusalem to be protected from being divided (Joel 3:2)







- ★ For the LORD to comfort the young and old alike (Isaiah 40:1)
- ★ That they would know the LORD desires to give them hope and a future, not evil (Jeremiah 29:11)



Believers in the land of Israel

- ★ For the Believers in Israel to be strengthened with power in their inner being, so Messiah may dwell in their hearts through faith, and that they would know the love of Messiah (Ephesians 3:16-19)
- ★ That they would be filled with God's will, wisdom and understanding; live a life worthy of Him; bear fruit in every good work; have great endurance and patience; and be grateful (Colossians 2:6-7)
- ★ For their protection, and that those around them would be drawn to Yeshua because of their love for Him and one another (John 17:11, 23)

Israel govt. and leaders

- ★ For Israel's leaders to be blessed and lead well, so Israel's citizens can live in peace and many will come to salvation (1 Timothy 2:1-4)
- ★ That they may be just and give their country stability, and be free from corruption (Proverbs 29:4)
- ★ That they would ask God for wisdom and follow His lead (James 1:5)





For Jewish people





- ★ The Lord to deepen our desire as believers for Jewish people throughout the world to be saved (Romans 10:1)
- ★ Believers to not be ashamed of the Gospel but share its saving power with everyone, Jewish People first and also Gentiles, so they have opportunity to believe (Romans 1:16)
- ★ The Lord to, even now, pour out a spirit of grace and supplication so that many will see Yeshua and mourn for Him, having a full revelation of who He is (Zechariah 12:10)
- ★ Jewish People to call on the Lord and be saved and blessed (Romans 10:12-13)
- ★ That they would turn to the Lord so the veil would be taken away (2 Corinthians 3:16)
- ★ Because Israel has experienced a hardening in part, may the fullness of the Gentiles come, so all Israel will be saved (Romans 11:25-26)

Aliyah - The return of Jewish people to Israel

- ★ All the Jewish people around the world who are responding to the prophetic call to return to the Land of Israel in these Last Days (Isaiah 11:10-16)
- ★ That they would experience God's protective care as they travel to Israel and make their home there (Isaiah 43:5-7)





- ★ People to understand and value the Jewish people the way God does (Romans 9:4-5)
- ★ The Lord will be a refuge for the Jewish people, that He will keep them from harm, and execute righteousness and judgment on their behalf (Psalm 9:9; Psalm 103:6)

The messianic movement around the world



- ★ Jewish believers in Yeshua to be filled with the knowledge of God through all spiritual wisdom and understanding, bearing fruit and giving thanks (Colossians 1:9-12)
- ★ Wisdom and revelation to know Him better and to know the hope, riches, and power available to them as believers (Ephesians 1:15-19)
- ★ Their hearts to be set on things above (Colossians 3:1-4)
- ★ That wherever they are and wherever they go, they will rely on the Lord, and preach the Word boldly, with signs and wonders (Acts 14:3)
- ★ That they would continue to meet together and exhort one another, more and more (Hebrews 10:25)



Righteous leadership

Pray for the very different parties representing different interests in Israeli society—for peaceful discussions and positive communication. Whether right or left wing, almost all of the Jewish politicians are united in their disapproval of Messianic believers in Israel. Today, ask God to raise up political leaders who will stand up for the rights of minorities like Messianic Jews and Evangelical Arabs.

"Open your mouth for the mute, for the rights of all who are destitute.

Open your mouth, judge righteously, defend the rights of the poor and needy." —Proverbs 31:8-9

Friends and enemies of Israel

- ★ That people and nations will take this Scripture to heart and bless Israel, thus receiving a blessing and not a curse (Genesis 12:3)
- ★ That the nations would understand the depth of God's wrath against those who don't follow Him (Isaiah 60:12)
- ★ For God to keep a watchful eye over His people, and bind the schemes and resources of their enemies so they can do them no harm (Zechariah 12:1-5; Psalm 91)





Underground believers



It's not easy for those from the Orthodox community to take their first steps as a Messianic believers. Many face total rejection from their family and friends, and in some cases even physical threats because of their faith in Jesus. Pray for these new believers, for safety and boldness to take those next steps in their faith! (Deuteronomy 31:6)
